Giants and their remains have been reported and found in 40 of the 50 States in America. They are spread from Alaska to Patagonia's Southern tip. The legends, drawings, eyewitness reports and remains have been found on every continent on the globe. They are recorded in the Bible and their graves are spread worldwide. Some contend the lack of physical evidence puts these beings in the mythological world only. Upon serious research one of the biggest criminals in hiding the physical remains has historically been the Vatican. Both in the Old World and New World Priests and clergy were responsible for collecting the bones from the local people and sending them to Rome. More recently in America, the Smithsonian has done the same. It isn't known if these things were kept or destroyed. With the passage of the "Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act (NAGPRA) in 1990, any of these bones or artifacts had to be removed from display. If possible they had to be returned to where they were found and buried properly. So if you want to know where they went ask the Smithsonian and the Native Americans.

Many of the "Mound" structures spread across America are related to burial tombs of very large people, with many artifacts supporting this thesis found when they were excavated. Many of the Native American Tribes have oral traditions of giants known by the various groups from their earlier times.

The following information comes from the book, "Giants of Record" by Jim Viera and Hugh Newman. The book has been referred to on the "History Channel" "Search for the Lost Giants" program.

Eyewitness and News Reports

- 1869 The Cardiff Giant In Cardiff, NY they reportedly found a 10' "petrified man." It was a hoax
- 27 May 1854 A short item appeared in the "Cambridge Chronicle" in England that described what some workman had found working on a new reservoir for Cherry Hinton. Nine skeletons were found:
"Several of them were of large size, and were evidently the remains of men who reached to a greater height than ordinary men in the present day."

- 1519 Alonzo Alvarez de Pineda was the first Spanish explorer to venture up The Mississippi River. He discovered large settlements of villages inhabited by local giants, not far from where the river empties into the Gulf of Mexico. He found them peaceable, settled among them while refitting and repairing his four ships.
- 1520 Explorer Ferdinand Magellan reported sighting groups of very large natives in Patagonia at the southern tip of South America. One of his men recorded in his diary:

“When he was before us, he began to marvel and be afraid, and he raised one finger upward, believing that we came from heaven. He was so tall that the tallest among us only came up to his waist.”

- 1540-41 De Soto encountered giants in what is now Alabama. They met with Chief Tuscaloosa and his tribe. The son of the chief (a youth) was described as a “great-limbed giant: heads of my tallest men reached only his breast.” The chief was “half a yard taller than any other.” These natives were described as proportionally well formed as any other human and both men and women were considered handsome.
- 1754-55 It is said that when then Colonel George Washington was building Ft Loudoun near Winchester, VA during the French and Indian War, while digging the foundations of the fort. Discovered Indian skeletons, Washington reported that they were seven feet long.
- 1821 Portsmouth, NH in “The Plough Boy and Journal of the Board of Agriculture” Vol 2, pg 239, describes “a human skeleton, 7' in length, the upper jaw had double teeth all around”
- 1856 “Boston Medical and Surgical Journal” had a article about skeletons found near Concord, NH described one as “extremely large, a very thick skull, all the teeth intact being double rows.”
- 13 May 1888 New York Times reported from Norwalk, CT

“There is a grave in Pine Island Cemetery that is no less than 10' long. It is that of Mrs Mary Titus, a widow, who was laid to rest there on Feb 5, 1769, a little over 119 years ago, in the nineteenth year of age. Tradition has it that Mrs Titus was a giantess, which fully explains the enormous length of her grave. It is situated in a remote corner of the large burying ground, and it's existence had been almost forgotten. A few days ago it was discovered by some city people visiting here.”

- Late 1800s around Akron, OH, many skeletons were found in the 7' -10' range, all reported with extremely large, heavy jaw bones that a normal human could place then around their own head.

- Jan 7, 1940 Victoria County, TX WPA workers unearthed what they believed to be the largest skull ever discovered and several large bones. Marcus Goldstein was the head anthropologist at the site. He had previously worked for the Smithsonian. These were put on display for some time at the University of Texas.

Double Rows of Teeth

Many of the found/reported giant type remains are reported to have double rows of teeth (DRT). These reports go back to 76 AD in Europe.

Smithsonian Files

Many of the reports end with something like this: “The bones were shipped to the Smithsonian Institute for further study.” From the late 1800's this subject was a contentious subject within the Institute. The “Lost Race” theory has always been popular, but not accepted by those in power. The Mounds found throughout the country are attributed to early American Natives, not a Lost Race. In 1879 John Wesley Powell founded the Bureau of Ethnology. It collected and stored records and artifacts from Native Americans. Powell appointed Cyrus Thomas as Director of the Division of Mound Exploration and was quietly a believer in the legendary lost race theory. In the first annual report from the Institute, Thomas outlined his intentions. “1. To make a collection of skeletons, especially crania found entombed in the mounds or graves.”

Powell soon brought Thomas to his way of thinking. Many think this was the start of “the Smithsonian to quash all evidence that showed that the mound builders were related to any other culture on any continent.” David H. Childers, World Explorer Magazine, Vol 1, no 3, 1993 in an article titled **Smithsoniangate**. In this article he

related a conversation with a prior employee of the Institute. This man asserted during his time there, “the Smithsonian at one time had actually taken a barge full of unusual artifacts out into the Atlantic and dumped them in the ocean.” Researchers have uncovered credible accounts of thousands of artifacts, treasures, sizable skeletons, and amassed an impressive knowledge of America's earlier inhabitants. If there is no **conspiracy**, then where are all these relics now? All one has to do is comb through the Institute's old annual reports to find their own statements about these relics.
